BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING
JUNE 26, 2013 – MEDIA CENTER
REGULAR MEETING – 6:00 P.M.**

The regular session of the Board was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by President Jonn Betzer with Vice President Shelly Wurzer-Kellogg, Directors Craig Martinson, Neil Matthias and Leanna Palmer, Superintendent Karl Kurt and Business Manager/Board Secretary Karla Hogan. Palmer moved, Wurzer-Kellogg seconded to approve the tentative as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Wurzer-Kellogg moved, Palmer seconded to approve the minutes from May 29, 2013 and May 31, 2013; the monthly financial reports; the list of invoices; resignations of Sue Meyer as .50 School Nurse for 2013-2014, Cyndi Nuehring as Teacher for 2013-2014; the hiring of Alyssa Calhoun as Junior High Robotics for 2013-2014, Mark Hazlett as Varsity Girls Basketball Coach for 2013-2014. Motion carried unanimously.

Wurzer-Kellogg moved, Palmer seconded to approve a football shed project bid from Don Hogan Construction in the amount of \$4,000.00 as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Matthias moved, Wurzer-Kellogg seconded to approve 28E Operational Sharing Agreements with North Linn for Transportation Management and Operations and Maintenance and with Alburnett for the School Nurse as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Wurzer-Kellogg moved, Martinson seconded to approve a contract with Tim Cronin as Superintendent for 2013-2014 in the amount of \$120,000.00, a contract with Jason McLaughlin as 7-12 Principal in the amount of \$79,000.00 and Elizabeth Campbell as Elementary Principal in the amount of \$75,250.00 as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Matthias moved, Wurzer-Kellogg moved to raise the sub rate for teachers to \$14.50 per hour for less than 4 hours and \$14.00 per hour for over 4 hours as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Matthias moved, Martinson seconded to approve the 28E Agreement with Kirkwood Community College for the Linn County Regional Center. Motion carried unanimously.
