## FREE LUNCH AND BREAKFAST FOR ALL STUDENTS AVAILABLE

Central City Community Schools will be offering FREE lunch and breakfasts for ANY student during our shutdown.


Families may pickup lunches curbside at Central City School High School entrance Door #1 between 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. Monday – Friday beginning Wednesday March 18.

We will also be offering rural delivery beginning Monday, March 24. Delivery times will be between 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. as well.

You may request a meal through our Google Doc Survey that will be emailed to our students, or by calling the High School or Elementary Offices @ 319-438-6181. We will need your request by 7:30 a.m. each day. Please indicate if you will be picking up or need delivery when it becomes available.

We are in uncharted territory, so we are rolling out a limited menu for Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. Lunches will be a PB&J uncrustable sandwich, fresh fruit, vegetable, milk and a treat. Breakfast will be cereal, fruit juice and milk. Meal choices will expand as we are able to assess the interest and need in the program. We appreciate your patience as we work this out.

Food is being stored and prepared following our local Health Department and Federal USDA guidelines and regulations. All foods are intended to be consumed immediately at home or refrigerated. Refrigerated items should be discarded within 7 days.
