Health and Safety

- All staff and students will be required to wear face coverings (masks and/or face shields). For students, age appropriate breaks and accommodations will be made for those needing it.

- All students and staff will be required to stay home if symptomatic or diagnosed with COVID-19.

What school will look like for the first day

- We will begin with onsite (face-to-face) learning with all students (4K-12) that are able to attend.
- MS/HS Students (grades 6-12) will have a homeroom teacher.
- MS/HS Students will stay with that teacher all day and take classes virtually.
- Elementary students (K-5) will stay primarily with their homeroom teacher
- Elementary students will have the same specials class (Art, PE, Music, and Computer) for an entire month.
- The District will provide virtual learning options for families
