Use your talents to artistically express yourself, reach out to others with encouragement, and share the feelings that many of us are confronting with the obstacles we have encountered during the pandemic.

Art will initially be displayed online on the Wellness Coalition Facebook page and Website with follow-up curation and a possible galleried exhibit at a future date.

Who can participate: Contest is open to high school students in the Mt. Vernon, Lisbon, and Central City school districts.

Theme: Entries should express and encourage how teens can emotionally cope in safe ways during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Type of Art to Enter: Open to original artwork including, but not limited to painting, drawing, photography, and illustration. Entries are not to exceed 11"x17".
