### COVID Illness District Policy

If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19, they will isolate until the following criteria have been met:

1. No fever for at least 24 hours without the use of medicine that reduces fevers **AND**
2. Symptoms have improved **AND**
3. At least 5 full days have passed since symptoms first appeared **AND**
4. Continue to wear a well-fitting mask for 5 additional days. If they are unable to wear a mask around others, they should continue to isolate for a full 10 days.

If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19 and does not have symptoms (asymptomatic), they will isolate until the following criteria have been met:

1. At least 5 days have passed from their first positive test **AND**
2. They continue to have no symptoms since the test **AND**
3. Continue to wear a well-fitting mask for 5 additional days. If they are unable to wear a mask around others, they should continue to isolate for a full 10 days.

If a student or staff member is awaiting COVID test results, the student or staff member is advised to quarantine until test results are received, regardless of symptoms.

### General Illness District Policy

Your child will be sent home from school or should be kept home from school if they have a fever over 100.0 degrees, is coughing uncontrollably, has vomited, or is having diarrhea. If a student or staff member is sent home or stays home due to illness, they will be advised to seek an evaluation by a health care provider.

If a student or staff member is sent home due to illness, they may return to school when the following criteria have been met:

1. No fever for at least 24 hours without the use of medicine that reduces fevers **AND**
2. No vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours **AND**
3. Symptoms have improved

If a student is treated with antibiotics for any illness (such as strep throat, pink eye, pneumonia), they may return to school when the following criteria have been met:

1. 24 hours after start of treatment **AND**
2. No fever for at least 24 hours without the use of medicine that reduces fevers.
